























TIPS & TRICKS: HOW TO SUCCEED. IN THE APPLICATION PROCESS

Make sure you understand the application process

- You can apply to maximum 3 WELS, each time filling in a new application form.
- You will have to provide your CV and motivation letter in each application.

Showcase your experiences in your CV and motivation letter

- Showcase how your educational and professional background relates to the WELS.
- Express your interest in the topic of the WELS
- Explain how the WELS can benefit your academic or professional life (thesis? / internship?)

Proofread and polish your application

- Ensure your application is error-free and written in a professional tone.
- Be mindful about the use of AI in writing your letter!
- Send the application(s) on time!
